Smith Cove LLC by Attorney J. Michael Faherty seeking to amend a previously granted Special Exception to enable petitioner to construct two (2) roof decks and two (2) dormers at **43 Rocky Neck Avenue** (Map 130, Lot 3).

James H. Niles by Attorney Robert J. Coakley seeking a Special Permit to alter/expand a nonconforming structure or use and Variances for lot area, lot width, lot frontage, frontage width to principal building and a Variance from the provisions of § 2.4.8 to enable petitioner to reconstruct a building that had been destroyed by fire over twenty years ago at **4 Palfrey Road** (Map 177, Lot 20).

Donald L. Robbins seeking to amend a previously granted Special Permit for automobile repair at **743 Western Avenue** (Map 194, Lot 82).

James A. Pratt & Deborah Nelson Pratt, Trustees of J. A. Realty Trust seeking to amend a Use-variance to enable petitioners to change the use at **95R Maplewood Avenue** (Map 41, Lot 6).
