Public notice is hereby given of the Waterways Application by Sam Avola to construct and maintain a two-family residential building with associated driveway, parking, landscaping, and utilities on filled tidelands of Hodgkin's Cove in Gloucester, Essex County. The project has been determined to be nonwater-dependent.

The Department of Environmental Protection, Waterways Regulation Program, will conduct a public hearing on the aforesaid project proposal on Thursday, April 5, 2018 at 3:00pm at Gloucester City Hall, 1st floor Council Conference Room, 9 Dale Avenue, Gloucester, MA. The Department will conduct this public hearing in order to receive information to be used in its decision on whether to grant a Waterways License pursuant to M.G.L. Chapter 91.

The Department will consider all written comments on this Waterways Application received by Monday, April 23, 2018 (Public Comments Deadline). Failure of any aggrieved person or group of ten citizens or more to submit written comments to the Waterways Regulation Program by the Public Comments Deadline will result in the waiver of any right to an adjudicatory hearing in accordance with 310 CMR 9.13(4)(c). The group of citizens must include no less than five citizens who are residents of the municipality in which the Project is located.
