Clean Energy Commission

Ms. Stout-Saunders touched briefly upon the appointment of two new members who are adding a renewed vibrancy to the Commission. She noted she’d been a member of the Commission for 10 years.

Councilors O’Hara and Nolan thanked Ms. Stout-Saunders for her willingness to continue her volunteer position.

2. CC2018-002 (Gilman) Request General Counsel review the GCO for a proposed amendment to certain sections of the GCO to insert “recreational marijuana” where appropriate (Cont’d from 02/05/18)

Councilor Gilman asked that the matter be postponed to April 30 as General Counsel has asked the Public Health Director to weigh in as well as the Interim Police Chief McCarthy and is awaiting their response.

6. CC2018-012 (Nolan) Amend GCO Ch. 22, “Traffic and Motor Vehicles” Sec. 22-267 “One-way streets-Generally” by ADDING Cliff Avenue from Lexington Avenue in an easterly direction to Shore Road (TBC 04/30/18)
