Public notice is hereby given of the Waterways Application by Ricci and Elizabeth Accardi to repair an existing seawall and demolish, rebuild, and elevate (above the FEMA 100-year base flood elevation) an existing single-family residence partially located over flowed tidelands of Lobster Cove at 742 Washington Street, Gloucester. The Project has been determined to be nonwater-dependent.

The Department of Environmental Protection, Waterways Regulation Program, will conduct a public hearing on the aforesaid project proposal on Monday, June 25, 2018, at 3:30pm at Gloucester City Hall, 1st floor Council Conference Room, 9 Dale Avenue, Gloucester. The Department will conduct this public hearing in order to receive information to be used in its decision on whether to grant a Waterways License pursuant to M.G.L. Chapter 91.

The Department will consider all written comments on this Waterways Application received by Wednesday, July 18, 2018 (Public Comments Deadline). Failure of any aggrieved person or group of ten (10) citizens or more to submit written comments to the Waterways Regulation Program by the Public Comments Deadline will result in the waiver of any right to an adjudicatory hearing in accordance with 310 CMR 9.13(4)(c). The group of citizens must include no less than five (5) citizens who are residents of the municipality in which the Project is located.
