Meeting called to order 6:10 PM by Catherine S. Members introduced themselves to those in attendance.

Agenda items taken out of order.

Maritime Gloucester – request for extension. Have hauled a schooner. Have done testing? – recording. Have repaired shiv, cart will move twice as fast as before. Participated in National Grids remediation in the harbor, which impacted their timeline. Vendor stopped making rollers and a new vendor was found, but product still needs to be tested. Have begun work on wracks, wooden structures that hold rollers. Need to work on blocking and vertical stanchions. Have received an MCC grant to build an observation deck off the back of hauling station?? Recording. Have paid for entire electrical system in stanchion motors. Requesting extension to the end of the year. This depends on success of new rollers. Boothbay Harbor will be testing the rollers by the end of August. Coordinating with Studio 1623 to get a video of the hauling. Saturday of schooner fest at least the tail of the schooner will be dipped and hauled.
