Meeting of May 11, 2021

N.B. Because of Covid restrictions, this meeting was held remotely by Zoom following the Governors procedures which were read by the chairman.

Members attending: (role-call) A. Pett, C. Gorga, B. Lambert, P.Fish, D. Porper (chair)

The Meeting was called to order by the chairman, David Porper, at 6:03 p.m.

The sole order of business was a request for Certificate of Appropriateness to Randolph Jones for the restoration/repair of the three windows, second story, on the front façade of 8 Center St. (The first floor presently houses K-9 Kuts)

Mr. Jones made a brief presentation, sharing his future plans for restoration, as well as his present request to replace or restore the trim and sashes of the three 2 over 2 wood windows on the second floor. The restorer will be Gordon Brennan who runs "Gambrel Acres" in CT which specializes in historic restoration.

All the members were impressed with the desire of the applicant to do the right thing.

It was moved (A. Pett) and seconded (B. Lambert) to grant a Certificate of Appropriateness to Randolph Jones for the restoration of the three second-floor windows on the front elevation of 8 Center St.

Unanimously approved by roll-call vote.
