This letter is a little early however I would rather provide you with as many details as are currently available. The North Shore Tour de Cure is looking to hold its annual ride on Saturday, May 22, 2010. It is our hope that the start/finish at the Gloucester High school and routes for the 25K, 50K, 100K and 160K will remain the same.

We are expecting roughly 650 cyclists and 150 volunteers to be on site. All persons associated with the Tour will check-in and be denoted with a wrist-band based upon their status of participation. 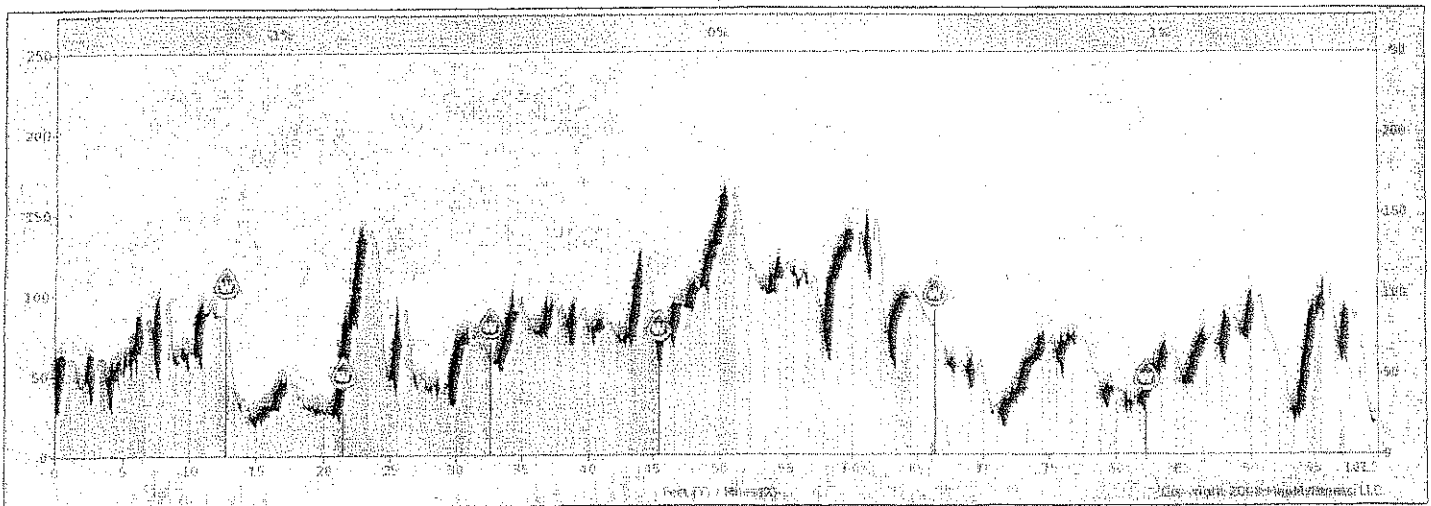
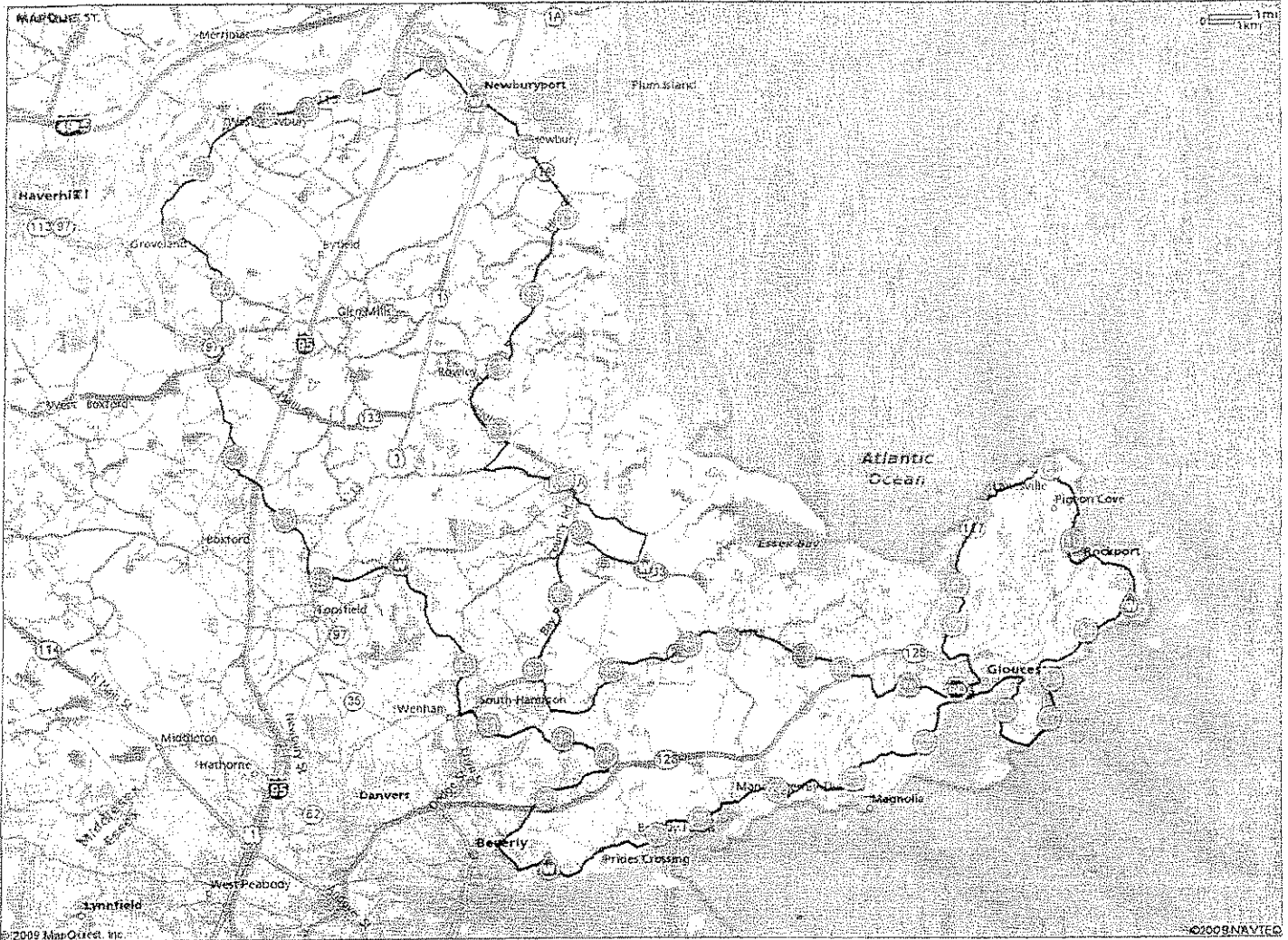

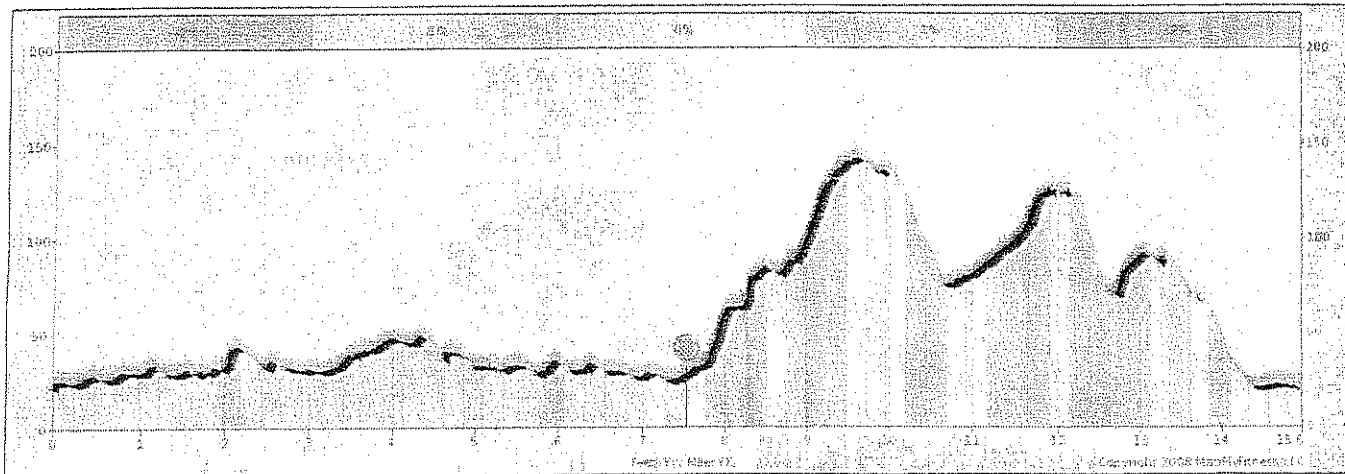
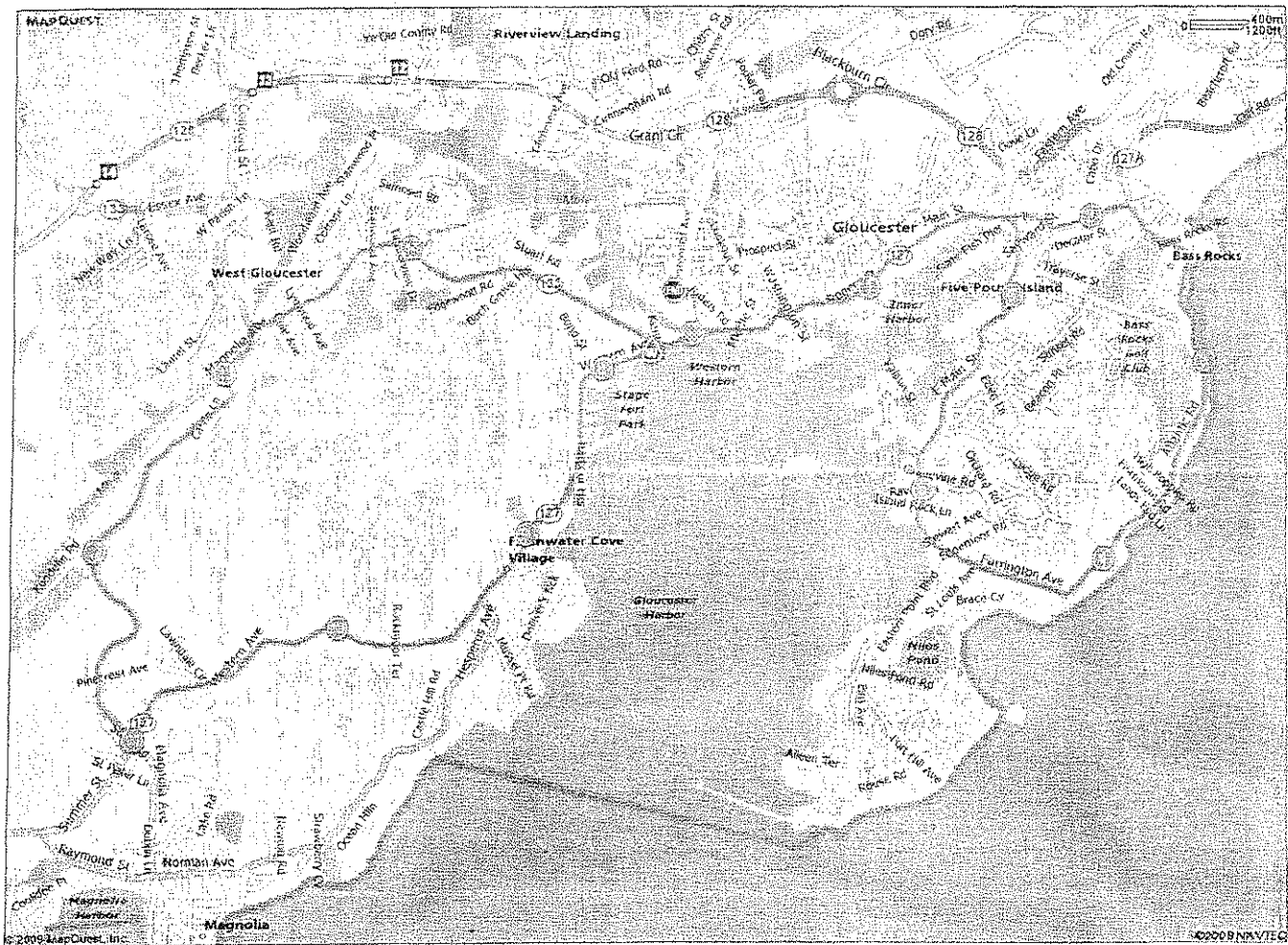


ROUTE DESCRIPTION
