Minutes, Meeting of 9 February 2016

The meeting was called to order by the chairman, David Porper, at 7:10 p.m.

One item was on the agenda, viz. a request for Certificate of Appropriateness by Danielle Glantz to install a sign at 5 Short Street in the West End for her new business. (The owners of the building are M. & G. Cracchiolo and D. D'Amico)

Since the members had already seen all the information in an e-mail previously sent, the applicant made a brief presentation noting the size of the sign, 36" X 14", and that it will be carved of mahogany wood. It will be hung on a wrought iron bracket to be installed on the right side of the building. The bracket will extend 40" over the sidewalk.

All agreed that the sign was appropriate. There was little discussion.

It was moved (Nancy Goodick) and seconded (Steve Goodick) that a Certificate of Appropriateness be granted for the sign as described to be installed at 5 Short St.

Unanimously approved

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 7:22.
