1. February 15, 2018 minutes reviewed and approved. The March 13 meeting was canceled due to blizzard.
2. Reviewed the Year 2017 memo to DPW and the Mayor. Final updates will be sent to Sandy.
3. CPA grant work was scheduled with Fannin Lehner Preservationist. They will do their first review of the stones in June.
4. Sandy discussed the 2nd annual workshop with Moss Rudley the Superintendent Historic Preservation Training Center, National Park Service. The Chris P Robinson Memorial, Gloucester Mass, Cemetery Workshop will take place August 3rd and 4th.
5. All paper work has been submitted to the City of Gloucester so \$6326 would be made to the Fannin and Lehner Preservationists. The Mayors office is expected to submit paperwork to the City Council for final payment.
6. Project status - Beechbrook (1878) contains the "fisherman rest" section, which was established by John Hays Hammond along with the City's Veteran section. The research continues on submitting the application to the National Register of Historic Places.
7. Project status - Influenza Graves Project (1918 - 2018) This data has been loaded into an Excel database and is on time to finish in 2018, the 100th year anniversary. Chris will connect with one of our city's Historical Commissioners.
8. Chris Maney sent the Cemetery Inventory checklist to committee and will be reviewed at the next meeting.
9. There has been no update from the city on the \$709 refund for Sand and Gravel.
