The meeting was called to order at 5:35 p.m.

1. *Memorandum from City Clerk re: request of Patrick Titus, Jr., to rename 602-606 Washington Street to Seaglass Lane per GCO Ch. 21, Sec. 21-3 "Street names" subsections (a) through (f) (Cont'd from 09/05/18)*

Councilor Gilman advised that 602-606 Washington Street is a permitted subdivision (on file). She noted that there is documentation signed (on file) from the City Engineer assigning street numbers and that the Committee has on file all five affirmative written department reports per GCO Ch. 21, Sec. 21-3(e) -- the ordinance has been met.

Councilors Gilman and **Holmgren** touched on the reasons for naming streets noting that as this is a new subdivision off the main roadway; by naming the road, it will differentiate it from Washington Street for 911 identification purposes. **Councilor Gilman** pointed out she did visit the subdivision finding that it was set back quite a bit from the main roadway.

COMMITTEE RECOMMENDATION: On a motion by Councilor Holmgren, seconded by Councilor Gilman, the Planning & Development Committee voted 2 in favor, 0 opposed, 1 (Lundberg) absent, to recommend that the City Council rename a new subdivision of land formerly known as 602-606 Washington Street, Map 112, Lots 25 & 93 (with final map and lot numbers to be created by City of Gloucester Assessors) pursuant to GCO Ch. 21, Sec. 21-3 "Street names" subsections (a) through (f) to be named as follows:

3A & B	Seaglass Lane
5A & B	Seaglass Lane
7A & B	Seaglass Lane

A motion was made, seconded and voted unanimously to adjourn the meeting at 5:42 p.m.
