FLOOD HAZARD ZONES

Please be advised that the Gloucester Board of Health, at their regularly scheduled meeting on January 6, 1986, adopted the following regulation pertaining to Flood Hazard zones:

HEALTH REGULATION PERTAINING TO THE FLOOD HAZARD ZONES

The Board of health, in reviewing all proposed water and sewer facilities to be located in the flood hazard zones established under the Local Ordinance Pertaining to General Wetlands, shall require that:

- The repair, replacement, or construction of water supply facilities within the flood hazard zones shall be designed to prevent infiltration of flood waters into the water supply system, and
- The repair, replacement, or construction of sanitary sewage into the flood hazard zones shall be designed to prevent infiltration of floodwaters into the system and discharges from the system into the floodwaters.
